



Book-in-a-Bag Report

You will need a medium to large paper bag. **NO LUNCH BAGS.**

On the outside:

On one side of the bag, include the title and author of the book, your name, an illustration, with a caption that explains the illustration. The writing must be large and creative. The illustration must be eye-catching, colorful and neat. Also, include your name.

On the other side of the bag, include a summary of the story in one well-written paragraph.

On the inside:

Place 5 items that help to tell the story. The items must be three-dimensional (no pictures, drawings, etc.). For example, to tell the story of The Three Pigs (no, you may not), you may put in a plastic pig, a toy wolf, some sticks, a Lego house, and a small pot.

With the items, retell the plot of your story.

Score Sheet

Title/Author/Illustration—all are included, with writing that is neat, creative, and colorful. /25

Summary is well-written, and includes the main aspects of the story. /25

Items—there are 5 three-dimensional objects that help to tell the story. /25

Oral presentation includes an accurate retelling of the story, including each item in the bag. /25
